Framed Pictures and Wall Hangings

Sections 1 to 6 (Items not to exceed 100" in perimeter)

1. Hand quilted wall-hanging
2. Machine quilted wall-hanging
3. Counted cross-stitch picture
4. Item of **traditional** rug hooking - not to exceed 30" x 36" finished size.
Design may be original, commercial or an adaption. Categories: primitive, widecut, fine shaded flowers or fruit, geometrics, landscape/pictorials.
5. Any other rug hooking technique not to exceed 30" x 36" finished size.
 - a. exhibitors who have been rug hooking for less than one year
 - b. exhibitors who have been rug hooking for more than one year**Prizes:** Gift Certificates to (a) and (b) 1st prize only by Purple Sock, Coldwater. (**Note:** 2 sections)
6. Any other wall-hanging or framed picture, not listed above, must be named (not latch hook)

Home Machine Sewing

Section 7 to 21

7. Lady's one-piece dress
8. Hostess apron
9. Bib
10. Shirt or blouse
11. Vest or jacket, man, woman, child
12. Adult housecoat (robe, PJ's, nightgown)
13. Halloween Costume, adult or child
14. Baby layette (3 pieces)
15. Child's outfit (not smocked, one or two piece)
16. Child's hat and mitts set
17. Child's sleepwear (robe, PJ's, nightie)
18. Homemade doll with machine sewn outfit (not over 15" in height)
19. Store bought doll with machine sewn outfit
20. Homemade teddy bear - not to exceed 15" in height
21. Any other article of "Home Sewing" - write what it is. Those listed above will not be judged in this Section

Glass

Sections 22 to 24

22. Hand Painted Glassware (vase, wine glass, plates, etc.)
23. Stained Glass not over 15" in any direction
24. Sun catcher

Miscellaneous Crafts

Sections 25 to 43

25. Hand-quilted small article (pot holders, placemat and/or runner)
26. Article of cross-stitch (counted or stamped)
27. Article of smocking
28. Hand embroidered article
29. Small item of hand weaving, including Swedish weaving
30. Wind chimes
31. Lady's fabric tote bag (must be completely hand made, not purchased and embellished. Please attach sample of fabric used)
32. Greeting card, computerized
33. Set of 2 fridge magnets, not crochet or knit
34. Folk art or Tole painted (not over 15" in any direction)
35. Handmade bird house or Feeder - any material (not over 15" in any direction)
36. Wooden hand carving (not over 15" in any direction) birds, decoys, etc.
37. Handcrafted jewellery
38. Scrapbook – one page
39. ****New**** Any article of needle felting
40. ****New**** Any article of wet felting
41. ****New**** Any article of Nuno felting
42. ****New**** "Something new from something old". An item made from recycled material
43. Any other article of Miscellaneous Crafts (holidays, Canada Day, etc.)

44. Christmas stocking

46. Door Ornament or wreath
47. Tree Ornament, not knitted or crocheted
48. Dinner table centrepiece (not to exceed 12" in any direction), not knitted or crocheted
