1. **Amateurs** only may enter - no dealers please
2. Exhibits to be the property of the exhibitor
3. Exhibitors may make **ONE** entry **ONLY** in any one class, unless otherwise stated
4. The same article **MAY NOT** be entered 2 years in a row
5. **Articles must be at least 50 years old (prior to 1967)**
6. Condition and age to be considered. Items with small cracks or flaws **will not** be disqualified
7. No article to exceed 15" high or photocopied unless otherwise stated
8. It is optional to put your phone number on Entry Tags **but** must be on your Entry Forms
9. Tags will be opened unless otherwise requested
10. **Displays will close on Sunday at 3:30 p.m. but antiques cannot be picked up until 4:00 p.m. (no earlier)**
11. Each exhibitor must present their pink exhibitor form when entries are picked up
12. **Remember do your research - make sure your article is 50 years old. There are a lot of reproductions out there**
13. **Here is what to do to check out any of the antiques for this year. You can google by using the word 'antiques' before the article e.g.: 'antique wedgewood piece' or 'antique black glass' or any of the others on the list. (it's actually fun to do and surprising as well)**

**This year we would like to display vintage dresses. If you would like to have your dress(es) displayed, we will be happy to hang them on the arena's glass wall in our section. Give one of us a call so we can make sure we have the space to hang them. Please bring in hangers along with your vintage clothing on Thursday, September 21st**
