Rules

2. A health check will be conducted by 3 CGS members in good standing and any goats failing to pass inspection must be removed and cannot be shown.
3. All goats must be registered with CGS and papers must be on site. A copy of the application of registration is acceptable for goats under 6 months of age.
4. All exhibitors must have liability insurance.

5. Prize money will be paid out up to 5th place in each section for classes 1-6.
6. All white or white top with black bottoms are to be worn in the show ring.
7. Pre-registration must be received by the show secretary by September 15, 2017. Please send entries as addressed on your entry form.
8. Entries are limited to 3 per exhibitor per class
