All items to be shown on plywood or medium density board with sides or Styrofoam plate, large enough to hold item, unless otherwise specified.

1. Slicing Cucumbers - 6
2. Carrots, long and slender (1" stems) - 6
3. Carrots, short and stubby (1" stems) - 6
4. Table Beets (1" stems) - 6
5. Slicing Beets (1" stem) - 6
6. Yellow Onions - 6
7. Green Peppers - 2
8. Yellow Peppers, hot - 3
9. Red Tomatoes - 6 (stems left on)
10. Green Tomatoes - 6 (stems left on)
11. Red Romano Tomatoes - 6
12. Green Romano Tomatoes - 6
13. Cherry Tomatoes - 6 (stems left on)
14. Grape Tomatoes - 2 clusters, mostly ripe
15. Yellow Tomatoes - 6
16. Heritage Tomatoes - 6 (there are some 300 varieties of Heritage or Heirloom Tomatoes). Variety must be named
17. Yellow Beans - 15
18. Green Beans - 15
19. Garlic - 6 heads (2" stems, roots on but trimmed, cleanliness counts)

20. A reasonable facsimile of "Poultry" – our theme - created using vegetables

- Minimum size 8" x 8" - maximum 15" x 15"
- Maximum of 4 Skewers (wooden)
- Unlimited Toothpicks
- Toothpicks and Skewers should be barely visible

In classes 21 to 26 judging is done on shape, form, fitness, uniformity and freedom from blemish. All dirt must be rinsed off, "do not scrub".

- 22. Red Potatoes (6 on a tray, must be named)
- 23. Late Potatoes (6 on a tray, must be named)

- 25. Miscellaneous Garden Class; any vegetable that is not already in a class. Judging of this class will be decided by the judge and the number of entries
