1. Wheat Quart Sealer. Variety named
2. Barley Quart Sealer. Variety named
3. Apples – three (3) Named
4. Largest Spaghetti squash - one (1)
5. Butternut squash – one (1)
6. Parsnips with 3” stem - three (3)
7. Collection of three (3) Ontario vegetables. Named
8. Oddest shaped carrot
9. Largest Beet
10. Pie pumpkin with stem – one (1); these are small and squat.
11. Vegetable display – not less than 3 varieties – arranged by student – accessories acceptable – no larger than 16” x 16”.
12. Onions 2” stems attached – three (3)
13. Collection of Gourds 6 minimum displayed in a decorative container.
14. Vegetable oddballs. Named
15. Baled hay – 1st cut, 10” slice
16. Baled hay – 2nd cut, 10” slice
17. Corn Sheaf – 3 stalks –variety and purpose named
18. Grain corn – 3 cobs
19. Largest pumpkin (displayed in front of stage) not weighed
