

# Rules and Regulations

For all children (up to the age of 14 or Grade 8)

**Note: The junior classes are between numbers 100 to 124.** Some classes are by Grades but others are by age. The child must be that age or grade by September 1, 2017.

1. Extra Entry Forms and Tags are available in June in the following ways:

Prize Books and Junior Pamphlets will be available at the Midland and Penetanguishene Libraries, Coldwater Library, Waubaushene Library, Coldwater Dental Office, Medical Centre, Ice Cream Shoppe, Coldwater and TD Canada Trust in Coldwater.
  - (d) Printing entry forms off the internet from our web site [www.coldwaterfallfair.com](http://www.coldwaterfallfair.com). Bring in all three copies upon registration
2. Take entries to the arena (at the back near the stage) on Thursday, September 21st between 1:00 p.m. - 8:30 p.m. Entry Tickets and Forms are available on Thursday 21st. Take your list of entries with you.
3. Any Junior (up to the age of 14 years or up to Grade 8) entering Classes 100 to 108 must get a Junior entry form and use the green entry tags to register with the Coordinator by the stage area.
4. Each child will be given an exhibitor number. If you wish a number beforehand, phone 705-826-0826. You will still be able to get a number on day your entries are brought in.
5. Take safety pins, elastic bands or twist ties, suitable to attach entry tags to exhibits. Scotch tape is not permitted.
6. If you are in school, provide name of school and your phone number on green entry tags.
7. All work of selecting and preparing the entry form must be done by the exhibitor. All entries must be completed since the 2016 Fall Fair. No handicraft kits are allowed in any entry.
8. Pupils must not make more than one entry in any one class (unless otherwise specified). Pupils may enter in a higher grade, but not in a lower grade. If rules for each entry are not followed, that entry will be disqualified.
9. The collecting and exhibiting of produce other than home grown is contrary to the regulations.

10. All entries must remain on display in the arena until Sunday at 4:00 p.m., otherwise the child will forfeit their prize money. Perishable articles remaining after 5:00 p.m. will be thrown away.
11. While the Coordinator will take every possible precaution under the circumstances to secure the safety of exhibits, the owners themselves must take the risk of exhibiting. Should any exhibit be accidentally damaged or stolen, the Coordinator will give their assistance towards recovery, but they will not make any payments of value thereof.
12. Juniors in Classes 100 to 108 will receive their prize money on the last day of the Fair, Sunday at 4:00 p.m. Bring in your copy of the Entry Form and see the Coordinator in charge.
13. Prize points are accumulated as follows: 1st - 5 points, 2nd - 4 points, 3rd - 3 points, 4th - 2 points, 5th - 1 point.
14. Juniors entering in Classes 110 to 124 will receive their prize/gifts on Sunday at 4:00 p.m. at the back of the arena in the school fair area.
15. The E. Lorraine Orr Trophy and \$10.00 will be awarded to the student who has the most points.
16. The Coldwater Foodland Award will be awarded to the school earning the highest percentage of points. Please note that the award must be presented back to the Coordinator by June 2018.
