Rules

1. Ages 13 to 17 years
2. No Exhibitor Fee
3. All exhibitors must fill in an Entry Form and use white entry tags only
4. Trophy for highest points from Class 200 and Class 201
5. Coordinator's Choice from Class 200 and Class 201. A \$10.00 prize will be awarded.

Judging will be done on the following: Look, Workmanship and Creativity

1. Duct Tape Item – using any colour of duct tape, be creative and create something (i.e. wallet, purse, headband, etc.)

2. Pinterest Copy Cat – create something that you found on Pinterest. Must include a picture of the Pinterest item with your entry. Will be judged based on creativity and similarity

3. Scrapbook Page – 1 page, theme “Family Memories”

4. Article of Handmade Jewellery - must be mounted on covered cardboard. Do not use glue to mount jewellery - use staples, pins, tape, etc.

5. Gift Basket – create a gift basket, using a minimum of 5 items, focus on the theme “**Poultry**”

6. Fall Centerpiece – any size, use a minimum of 5 different materials

7. Create a Poster - “Promoting the Coldwater Fall Fair” (name and date must be on the poster)

a) Must be hand drawn by a student in Grade 9 to 12 and must include name of Fair and dates (September 22, 23, 24, 2017)

b) Poster size: Minimum without a border 8 ½" x 11" (22 cm x 28 cm). Maximum without a border 11" x 17" (28 cm x 44 cm)

- c) Each entry must be centered on Cardstock or Bristol Board exposing on all four sides showing a 2" (5.5cm) border
- d) Name of Fair, District 5, contact person, (Amanda Murray), owner of poster to be clearly labeled on the back of each entry
- e) Winning poster from each class at each Fair will be eligible to enter the District competition. The poster winning at District will go to the 2018 OAAS Convention
